

Lab Safety Contract: Mr. Lanter Chemistry and Physics

Safety is of paramount importance when conducting lab activities, whether in the actual laboratory or in a classroom setting. Therefore a grade of zero will be result of any of the following safety procedures are violated. Depending upon the severity of the infraction, a parent conference may be required before the student is allowed to continue additional lab work.

1. Experiments/activities are designed to be completed in a class period with proper preparation. Students should make efficient use of time, but must ALWAYS walk in the lab. DO NOT RUN.
2. ALWAYS wear goggles. Some labs may require gloves and/or aprons.
3. NEVER eat, drink, or chew gum.
4. ALWAYS pull long hair away from the face and pull it back.
5. NEVER touch another student's or group's lab.
6. NEVER cheat by altering lab data.
7. ALWAYS write your own lab reports or complete your own data analysis.
8. ALWAYS pour stock solutions out of the container. NEVER pour it back into the reagent bottle.
9. Set up any/all equipment/materials carefully to avoid accidents. ALWAYS report any accidents to the teacher immediately.
10. ALWAYS practice teamwork by assigning group members specific tasks.
11. ALWAYS clean up the lab. When you leave, it should look exactly the way it did when you entered.

ALWAYS FOLLOW THE TEACHER'S INSTRUCTIONS THE FIRST TIME THEY ARE GIVEN. IF THERE ARE QUESTIONS ABOUT PROCEDURE, RAISE YOUR HAND FOR CLARIFICATION. I have read the above procedures, understand them, and agree to abide by them as outlined in the **LAB SAFETY CONTRACT**.
